## A toolbox for Europe

Nine partners from six countries and one goal: to strengthen European awareness through transnational projects and innovative methods. „Building Bridges for Europe“ (BBE) is the name of the project, which is funded by the EU for two years. At the heart of the project is the development of an online toolbox containing a collection of innovative pedagogical methods and projects designed to promote European awareness, critical thinking and the reduction of prejudice.

## Easy to handle

The digital toolbox, written in English, contains 27 projects carefully selected and analysed by the partners and over 50 pedagogical methods. The application of which in general and vocational (further) education is shown step by step in the project context. The collected knowledge is freely available, pictures illustrate the descriptions. A quick search via various filters inspires the use of innovative methods. A glossary provides short descriptions of the methods that can be used in different pedagogical contexts, as well as a link to the institutions that have carried out the projects.
